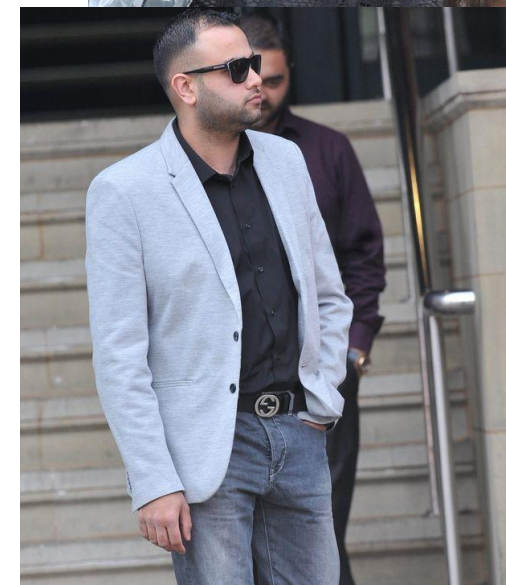
A genuine accident?

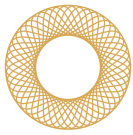




...or a choreographed collision?

- Alina Khan – driver of silver Audi
- Kamran Yasin – driving beside the victim on the inside lane, leaving him no chance to manoeuvre out of the way.
- Alina Khan brought a claim
- Khan had claimed that she hadn't braked during the incident, and there were no witnesses to the collision, but it had been seen by a man in a hair salon.
- The video footage was then assessed and an investigation launched, which led to arrests being made by the City of London Police's Insurance Fraud Enforcement Department.
- All pleaded guilty to conspiracy to commit fraud.
- Khan was jailed for 14 months, suspended for two years.

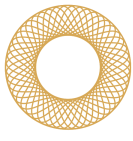
